We offer camps and clinics for kids of all ages, and at a variety of times and dates. Campers get the personal instruction needed to improve in specific areas, including physical, mental, and strategic aspects of the game. #### YOUTH FUNDAMENTALS CAMPS For boys in grades: 3-6 12:30-2:30 p.m.

These camps are intended to cover all aspects of the fundamentals of the game. Spend time on hitting, fielding, throwing, baserunning. The goal of this camp is to teach repeatable fundamentals in an appropriate group size, and maximize our time to balance instruction and repetition.

\*Participants are encouraged to bring their own bat. Youth bats are not provided.

#### WINTER PITCHING/CATCHING & INFIELD CAMPS For boys in grades: 7–12 1:15-2:45 p.m.

These camps are designed to isolate your specific position in the field and break down its components. Pitchers will focus on mechanics, ball location, changing of speed, ways to increase velocity, and injury prevention. Catchers learn blocking and receiving, set-up and stance, throwing and controlling the game. Infielders will receive instruction on both general fielding concepts as well as position specific instruction. All position groups will be separated based on age and skill level. \*Catchers gear will NOT be provided. If you catch, you will need to bring your own gear

#### WINTER HITTING CAMPS For boys in grades: 7-12 3-5 p.m.

Coaches will break down each individual swing and teach proper ways to be successful at the plate. Age groups and skill levels will be separated to optimize the overall experience.
